Guest Agreement & Release

We're so glad you're here. The Addiction Podcast – Point of No Return exists to amplify voices like yours — people with real stories, hard-won experience, and messages that matter. We serve as a relay point and communication channel, helping you reach help and give hope a wider audience than you might on your own. This agreement simply documents how we do that, and what we're each agreeing to. ("the Program" refers to The Addiction Podcast – Point of No Return throughout.)

Participation & Recording

By agreeing to appear on the Program, you're consenting to participate in an audio and/or video recorded interview. Your voice, image, name, likeness, biography, and interview content may be recorded, edited, published, distributed, and promoted as part of the Program — all in service of getting your message out.

Usage Rights

To publish and distribute your episode widely, you grant The Addiction Podcast – Point of No Return and Sigal Consulting Inc. a non-exclusive, worldwide, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free license to use, reproduce, publish, distribute, display, edit, excerpt, promote, and share your interview content, in whole or in part.

This includes use on:

- Podcast platforms (such as Spotify, Apple Podcasts, and similar services)
- Video platforms (such as YouTube and similar services)
- Social media platforms (including Facebook, Instagram, X/Twitter, TikTok, LinkedIn, and similar channels)
- The Program website, newsletters, and promotional materials
- Short-form promotional clips, excerpts, reels, captions, transcripts, summaries, and similar media formats

Platform Distribution

Getting your episode to as many listeners as possible means working with the major platforms where audiences already are. You authorize the Program to make your episode available through third-party distribution platforms and services (such as podcast directories, streaming services, and video hosting platforms) solely for the purpose of distributing and promoting the Program. This does not permit the sale of your content or likeness to unrelated third parties.

Editing & Production

We may edit your interview for length, clarity, audio/video quality, or platform requirements — always with the goal of presenting you in the best possible light. We will never intentionally misrepresent the meaning or intent of anything you say.

AI, Transcription & Accessibility

To make your episode as accessible and discoverable as possible, we may use automated tools including AI-based services for transcription, captioning, summaries, translations, editing assistance, searchability, and promotional content creation.

Name & Likeness

Promoting your episode means putting your name and face to it. You grant the Program permission to use your name, professional information, photograph, biography, voice, and likeness to publish and promote your episode and the Program itself — including in episode artwork, show notes, social media posts, press materials, and the Program’s website. Your name and likeness will not be used to imply endorsement of unrelated products, services, or sponsors.

Responsibility for Statements

Your story is yours to tell — and you’re in control of what you share. You are responsible for the statements, opinions, and information you choose to include in your interview. We’d gently ask that you avoid sharing confidential or sensitive information that you wouldn’t want made permanently public, and that you refrain from identifying third parties — such as treatment facilities, healthcare providers, or individuals — by name in any way that could be considered defamatory or harmful to them.

No Obligation to Publish

While our intention is always to publish every interview we record, we want to be transparent that participation does not constitute a guarantee of publication or distribution.

Public Nature of Content

This is actually the good news: once your episode is out in the world, it stays there. Podcast and social media content may remain publicly accessible indefinitely and may be shared or reshared by listeners and third parties well beyond our own channels — extending the reach of your message long after publication.

Release of Claims

By participating voluntarily, you agree to release and hold harmless The Addiction Podcast – Point of No Return, Sigal Consulting Inc., its owners, hosts, producers, employees, contractors, affiliates, and distribution partners from claims arising from your participation in the Program — except in cases of intentional misconduct on our part.

Informational Content

The Program is a place for real stories, education, and conversation — not professional advice. Statements made by guests reflect their own personal experiences and opinions and should not be taken as medical, legal, or professional guidance by listeners.

Consent by Registration

By applying to appear as a guest on The Addiction Podcast – Point of No Return and completing the guest registration form, you confirm that you’ve read and agree to the terms of this Guest Agreement & Release — and that you’re excited to share your message with our audience.

No additional signature or written consent is required. Submitting the registration form, scheduling an interview, or participating in the recording constitutes your full and binding acceptance of these terms.
